## **Terrible Two 2004 Results**

Cool weather, great support, and a little good luck conspired to make the 2004 edition of the Terrible Two double century about as close to perfect as it could be.

272 riders set off into the sunrise at 5:30 am on Saturday, June 19. That is the largest field in the history of the event. With so many riders on the road together, one might be justified in expecting at least a little chaos and carnage, and yet, as far as we know, there was not one single crash in the entire event...certainly nothing significant.

Once again, TT participants caught a break with the weather. At midweek, it was 104° in Cloverdale, but in two days the temperature dropped over 20°, and on the 19th, the official high was a comfortable 82°. The only downside to the weather was a bothersome headwind that seemed to pop up all over the place, regardless of which direction one was riding (except for the brief run down the coast: that at least was a tailwind). Overall, the pleasant weather was a nice change from last year's inferno, and it played a big part in allowing 216 entries to complete the course (203 within the "I Did It!" time limit).

The first rider in was once again Santa Rosa homeboy Brian Anderson, in a time of 10:59. In his previous victories, Anderson has shared the first place laurels with another rider each year, but this time he came in solo, eight minutes ahead of TT rookie Bo Hebenstreit of Campbell. He now becomes the first three-time winner of the Terrible Two.

Pat Ross of Hayward repeated her performance of last year as the first woman finisher, with a time of 12:46. Only 23 women started, and five of them were stokers. But while their numbers were small, their performance was not: among the woman, only one solo rider and one stoker failed to finish.

In spite of being the first official female finisher, Ross would no doubt agree that her very good ride was actually eclipsed by that of another woman. Catharina Berge, who holds the TT record for women (11:35 in 2002) and shares the mixed-tandem record with Paul McKenzie (11:42 in 2003), needed a new challenge this year. She decided to ride the course twice around, back to back, with the second circuit more or less corresponding with the actual TT

She knocked off the first double in 12:41, beginning on Friday afternoon and riding Skaggs and Fort Ross in the dark. Then she began her second loop a couple of hours ahead of the official TT start. Her second loop was a more sedate 13:52, and the total was 26:33, absolutely shattering Trent Norlund's "Horrible Four" record of 38:39.

Paul McKenzie did strike one blow for the males of the species by setting a new men's (and overall) tandem record of 11:20, with former TT winner Ray Plumhoff stoking. (The overall record had been the mixed tandem record listed above.)

Zach Kaplan set a new recumbent record, his 13:31 topping James Kern's 13:54 from 2003, but still a long way short of Eric House's 'bent record of 12:53 on the old 211-mile course.

Also of note was the ride of another former TT champ, Ken Eichstaedt, who once again—for the second time—completed this hilly tour on a fixed gear...not only a challenge on the climbs but on the descents as well.

And finally, a near record for another TT rookie, Gerd Rosenblatt of Berkeley, who finished in a time of 15:09. Just a mid-pack time, you say? But what if we told you Rosenblatt is 70 years old? In fact, he's just a couple of months shy of tying John Abbe as the oldest TT finisher ever.
